The energy transition is going to require significant new investment and infrastructure, in both generation and transmission. The energy 'Trilemma' points to the balance between security, affordability and environmental sustainability. Course outline

Engineers Australia / API Graduate Learning Program – Power and Renewable Energy is structured into five modules, building a graduate's skill set as they progress through the program.

Each module begins with a virtual workshop introducing participants to the topics via a range of experiential learning activities.

Learning and development is continued in an online, self-directed environment including webinars and social learning, complemented with one-on-one support to track the progress of participant's goals.

Modules

API EXECUTIVE INSIGHTS (PART 1)

Participants will join the API Executive Insights – Early Career Stream where they will gain insights towards learning skills and solving challenges from industry leaders.

They will also be guided through a capability selfassessment and the creation of a power-focused skills development plan, setting up an industry sector foundation of knowledge for the next module.

PERSONAL EMPOWERMENT

Lays the foundations for professional and personal growth. Participants are equipped with the skills to take personal responsibility for the planning and development of their own careers. They go on to develop self-awareness in order to regulate their emotions and improve interpersonal skills.
